

Pickle Jar Terrarium

Make your very own terrarium at home with just a few simple items!

Materials Needed:

- Empty glass pickle jar with lid
- Pebbles
- Potting soil
- Moss
- Stick
- Spray mister.



Instructions:

1. Remove the outside label of the jar and wash.
2. Add at least a one-inch layer of pebbles to the bottom of the jar.
3. Add a layer of potting soil that is a few inches high.
4. Harvest a small piece of moss growing outside.
5. Add the moss on top of the soil and press it down using a stick. You can add a larger pebble or rock on top of the moss for decoration.
6. Spray the moss several times with your spray mister, screw the lid on and place in a bright spot out of direct sunlight.
7. Spray your terrarium once every month or when condensation stops forming in the jar. If the jar becomes too foggy and lots of water droplets form, then you might have overwatered it. Just leave the lid off for a bit before you place it back on. If the moss develops brown spots, it's too dry. A little condensation in the early morning and evening are normal.
