# About Randall's Island Park

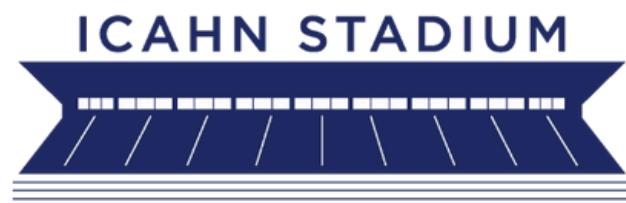

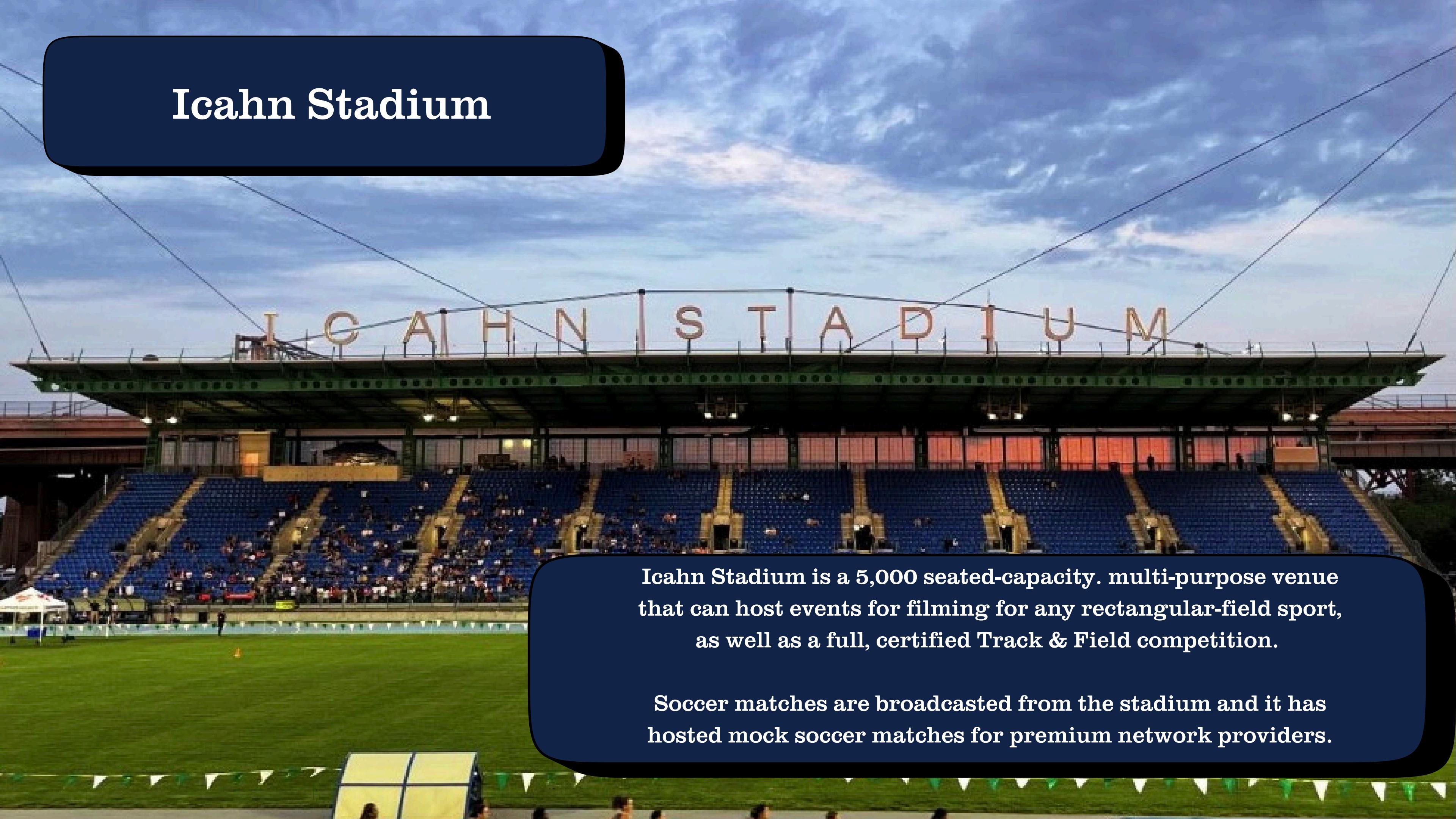

# Icahn Stadium



Icahn Stadium is a 5,000 seated-capacity, multi-purpose venue that can host events for filming for any rectangular-field sport, as well as a full, certified Track & Field competition.

Soccer matches are broadcasted from the stadium and it has hosted mock soccer matches for premium network providers.



## Asphalt Pad & Parking Lots

This 187,000 square-foot space (approximately four acres) has been home base operations for many film shoots. For context, see the photo on this slide of part of the [Cirque du Soleil](#) setup in 2025.

Productions have built full sets on our Asphalt Pad and this massive space is unmatched in all of NYC. Our parking lots have been used for action scenes. Lot F is notable for a famous scene (The French Connection).

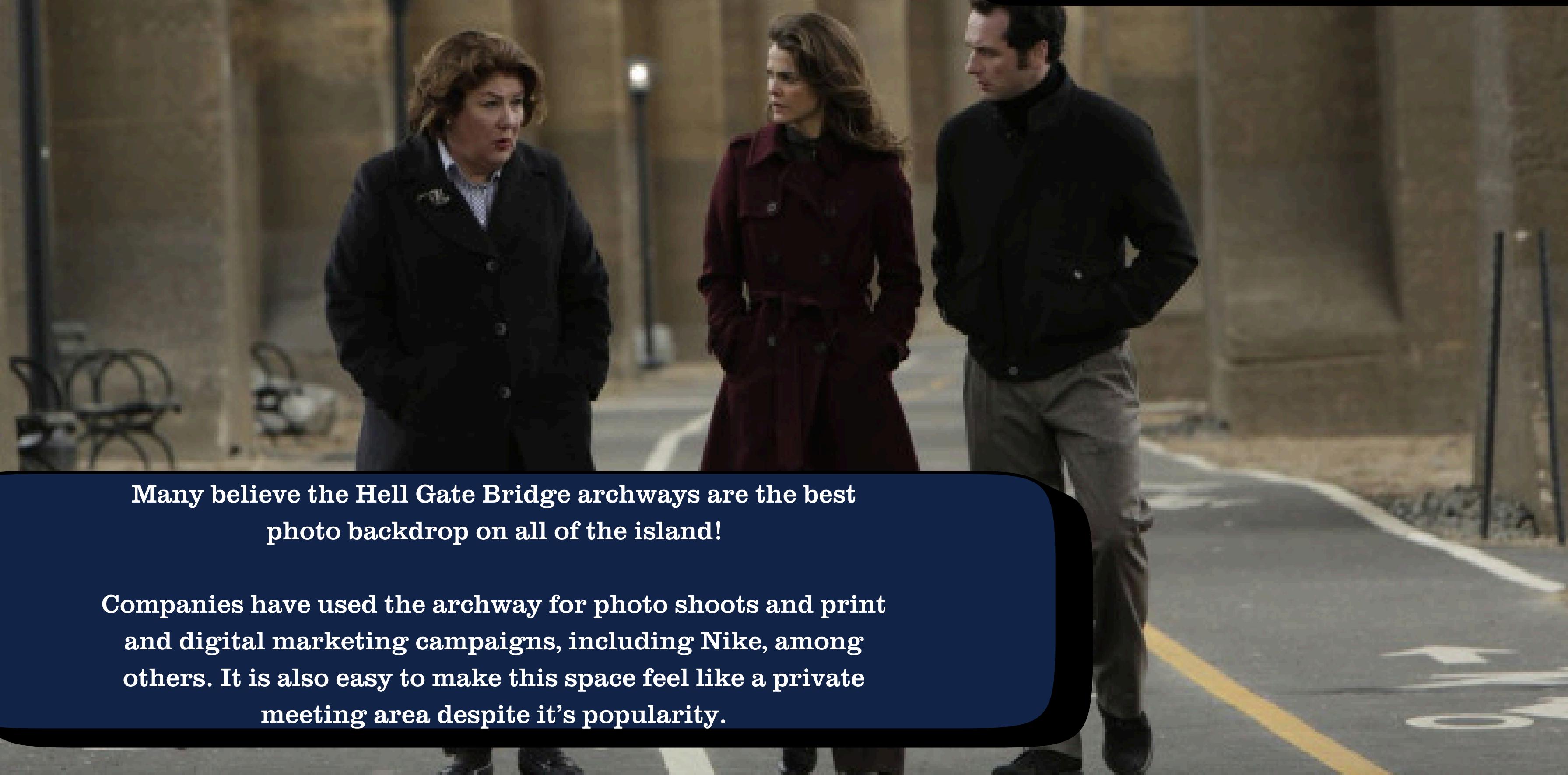
# Sports Fields

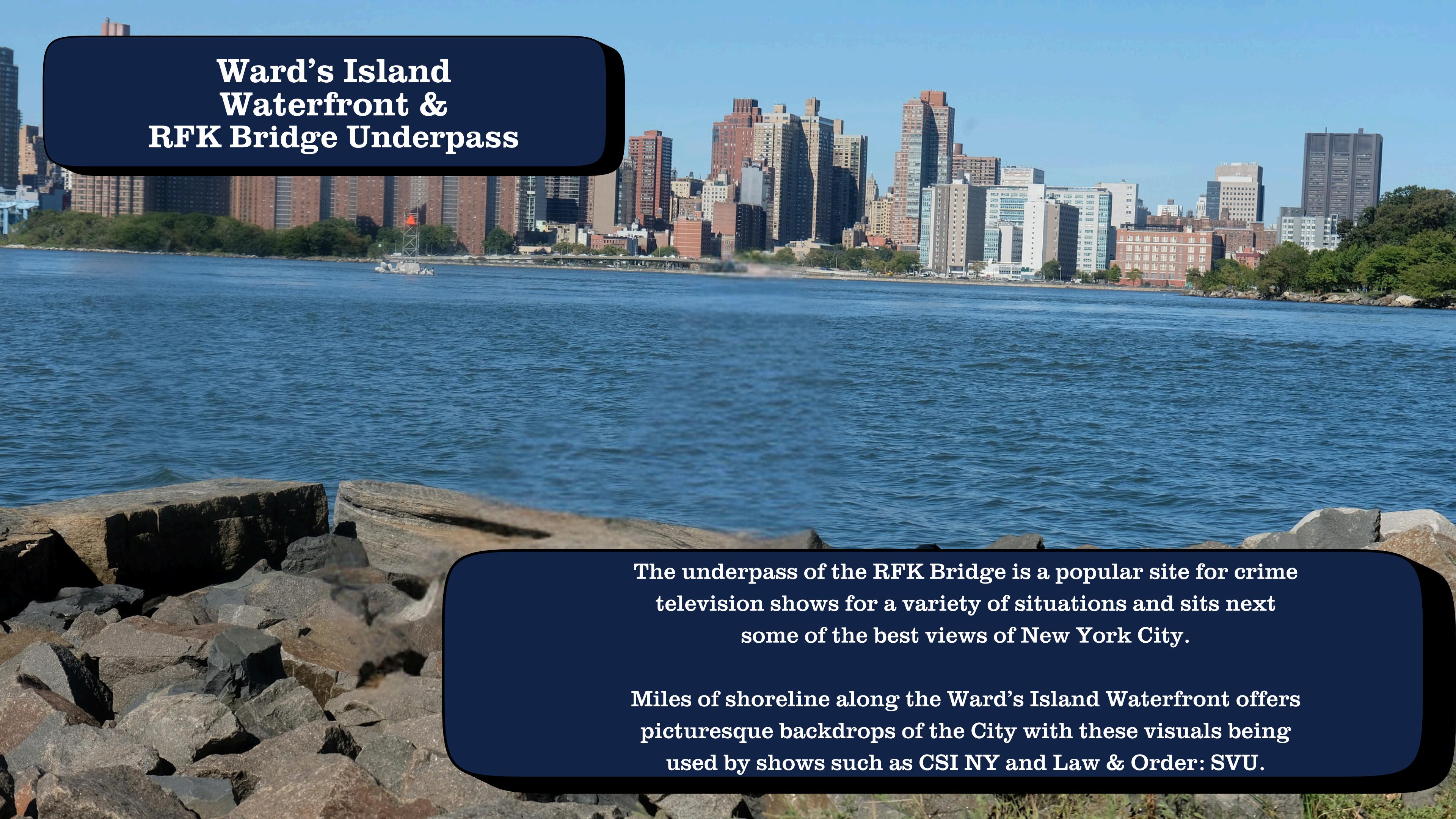
One of RIPA's top priorities is providing a premium experience for players of all ages as these fields are maintained at a level commesurate with any NYC Park.

# Hell Gate Bridge



Many believe the Hell Gate Bridge archways are the best photo backdrop on all of the island!

Companies have used the archway for photo shoots and print and digital marketing campaigns, including Nike, among others. It is also easy to make this space feel like a private meeting area despite its popularity.



## Ward's Island Waterfront & RFK Bridge Underpass

The underpass of the RFK Bridge is a popular site for crime television shows for a variety of situations and sits next to some of the best views of New York City.

Miles of shoreline along the Ward's Island Waterfront offers picturesque backdrops of the City with these visuals being used by shows such as CSI NY and Law & Order: SVU.
